LISLE, Ill. – Construction is complete on the newest addition to the Benedictine University Dan and Ada Rice Center, the Bartlett Golf Center.

This new 1,600 square foot state-of-the-art facility features two Sportsman model golf simulation units from Full Swing Golf. Each simulation unit has custom hitting to simulate fairway, rough and sand conditions. The simulation units allow the golfer to experience an interactive practice facility and more than 100 selected PGA courses. Adjacent to the golf simulators is a 1,000 square foot putting and chipping surface. Included in the facility will be the latest video and swing analysis software.

The Bartlett Golf Center was made possible through a leadership gift from William Bartlett, President / Owner of Corporate Strategies and Solutions Inc., of Naperville. “It didn't seem fair that our golf team was relegated to practicing at an off-site location,” Bartlett said. “My wife Gayle and I believe in investing in young adults and our golf center contribution certainly reflects our philosophy.
